



The exclusive worldwide sales and distribution rights to the Auto Mag Pistol were assigned formally to L.E. Jurras and Associates, Inc. in September '74. The new company, located in Shelbyville, Indiana, is headed by L.E. Jurras. Founder and president of the Super Vel Cartidge Corp., international handgun hunter and author, Jurras is widely known as a devotee of all forms of handguns.

In addition to AMP distribution, L.E. Jurras and Associates, Inc. has assumed all warranty and service responsibilities including the supply of parts, accessories, custom work and special tuning. Ammunition and empty, unprimed cartridge cases will also be available through the company.

Much was written in the early part of '74, suggesting that the High Standard Co. would buy the manufacturing rights to and sell the AMP. Although High Standard did list the gun and some AMP's were made with their markings, the sale never did actually occur. Instead, in mid '74, the T.D.E. Corp. (manufacturers of the AMP) refinanced and tooled up to produce completely new guns to be distributed by the L.E. Jurras firm. Thus, for the first time, the Auto Mag will be fully supported by a corporate entity, completely separate from the manufacturing facility. New guns - from this date forward - distributed by L.E. Jurras and Associates, Inc. will carry the conventional T.D.E. markings and will also be enblazoned with the lion's head logo of the Jurras firm.





smoothly and reliably with manageable recoil.

The .44 Auto Mag comes with target-type sights, featuring a non-glare ramp front, and a fully adjustable square blade rear. The two are connected by an integral ventilated rib which is part of the barrel assembly. This entire assembly is easily removed for cleaning, by locking the bolt to the rear, releasing the catch on the left front part of the frame and sliding the assembly forward.

When the barrel assembly is removed, the complete bolt assembly is exposed for cleaning or lubrication. The bolt has six locking lugs and operates within the frame by means of a large pin which is inserted through a cam slot in the bolt body in order to provide bolt rotation and retention.

The pistol is constructed of a stainless steel developed expecially for the aerospace industry. Auto Mags are boxed in a black plastic carrying case with a set of Allen wrenches, a supply of Auto Mag lubricant and an instruction manual.


