AUTO MAGS WIN

Ray Chapman and W. A. "Buck" Toddy of So. California, won the two-man Team Championship at the recent 2nd National Handgun Metallic Silhouette Championships, held 1,2,3, October 76; at Ft. Bliss Rod & Gun Club, El Paso, Texas.

Both Ray and Buck shot 10½" bbl. 44AMP's, they fired a combined score of (56) out of a possible 80. As a point of interest, Ray Chapman won the World Combat Match Championship in 1975 and was Runner-up in the 1976 World Combat Matches. W. A. "Buck" Toddy was the 1976 Western Regional Metallic Silhouette Champion.
